## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Please read the following information carefully. A review of the registration procedures will assist with a successful registration process

### GENERAL INFORMATION:

Application postmarked prior to Monday, March 12, 2012 will be returned to sender. We will only accept registration forms sent via regular first class U.S. mail with an electronic postmark dated no earlier than March 12, 2012. Registration will be taken in the order they are received. Classes have limited space available. If your first choice is full, your payment will be mailed back to you.

Online/Walk-in registration will begin Monday, March 19, 2012 at 10:00am and continue until classes are full.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH. Make checks or money orders payable to: City of L.A. Dept. of Recreation & Parks. Mail form to Granada Hills Recreation Center, 16730 Chatsworth St., CA 91344.

There will be a \$35.00 collection charge for any insufficient, cancelled, or stop payment checks. We only accept personal checks, cashier's checks, & money orders. No post dated, out of state, or temporary checks accepted. Check must contain name & address printed by the bank. Valid drivers license and/or picture ID required for all checks. All classes must be paid in full at time of registration.

### REFUND POLICY

A non-refundable 15% administrative fee per class or sports league registration will be assessed by the Recreation Center for any patron granted a refund, change, or transfer. There will be no refunds granted after the first week of classes. No full refunds will be issued unless a class or sports league is cancelled by the Recreation Center. No refunds to patrons making false statements on registration forms. Please allow 4-6 weeks for processing of refunds.

Administration reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if minimum enrollment is not met. Patrons who decline to accept combined or alternative class will be given a refund minus 15% administrative fee. If minimum enrollment is not met by April 14, 2012 classes may be cancelled.

It is the parent's responsibility to get the child to class without a phone notice from the Recreation Center. No make up classes for a participant's absence or illness and no substitutions. Age criteria must be met on the FIRST day of class.

Neither the City of Los Angeles or Granada Hills Recreation Center carries insurance! Patrons must carry their own insurance.

All information in the brochure is subject to change without prior notice. Also, the classes & programs in this brochure may be subject to cancellation.

**Existing Customer**- type your username & password. If you do not remember it, click on "Forgot your Username or Password?" and it will be emailed to you.

To add another participant, click on "New Participant" and enter their information.

On the next screen click on the name in the participant box who will be registered for the activity. To register multiple participants for the same activity. To register multiple participants for the same activity, hold down the CTRL button on the keyboard & select all of the names. NOTE: If a participant is not the proper age it will not let you register for the activity. Click "Next" when you are done. Enter your credit card number (with no spaces or dashes) as well as the expiration date. Once again, make sure your billing address for that specific card matches with the address on the screen. When you are done click on "Next." This may take a few minutes to complete the process. DO NOT click on "Next" more than once, this could result in multiple charges. Don't forget to print your receipt.
